



BAE Mini-Mud Craze FAQ

Can parents run the course with their child(ren)?

- Absolutely! Just register each member of the family who wishes to participate (\$30 per participant until May 24th at which time you would register on-site for \$35 per participant). We want to be safe, so please understand that waves are set up for safety purposes. We want older kids to go first so no one gets hurt, however, your family may run together. The goal isn't to finish first . . . but to finish and have fun!

Will there be food and beverages at the event?

- Yes! Vendors will begin serving at noon.

I can't make the scheduled start time. Can I start later?

- Yes. Once we confirm your wave time, email us and we can assign you to a time that works around your schedule.

I don't want to stand around for a long time waiting. Is there anything else to do?

- Yes! There will be food, music, and vendors all afternoon. We strongly encourage you to bring a change of clothes and a bag for all your dirty clothes!

Where should I park?

- Barat Academy has a parking lot in front of the school. If that lot is full, volunteers will direct you to the alternative lot next door at the church.

Where is check in on day of registration?

- There will be a tent marked with a sign "Check-In" as you approach the back of the school. You may register on the day of the event – but please know that the cost for the "Day of Registration" is \$35 and **does not** include a t-shirt or medal and is available at the check-in table only. Any volunteer can direct you.

What happens if it rains?

- If you are a participant, enjoy getting muddy and wet!! If you are a spectator, bring your umbrella and raincoat! The event will only be delayed if there is lightning.
- ***Be sure to bring a clean set of clothes for each participant and a container/bag to transport muddy clothes!!***
