COVID-19 Impact on Class of 2023

Barat Academy began live virtual learning March 2020 through the end of May 2020. Virtual learning began at 8:00 a.m. and concluded at 3:00 p.m. using the block schedule of 60 minute classes. Students were required to sign in and out each day. They were responsible for completing posted assignments and were invited to join group discussions or teacher presentations during their class time. Students were issued a grade for second semester. The integrity of this grade was reinforced by virtual classroom discussions, presentations, tests and projects. Every student had a laptop and there was careful consideration given to support those students who may not have had access to reliable internet service. Final exams were included in final grades. The 2020-2021 academic year attendance was in-person though some opted for virtual learning. Attendance, grading and expectations remained the same regardless of how the student attended class. The 2021-2022 academic year was the same.
